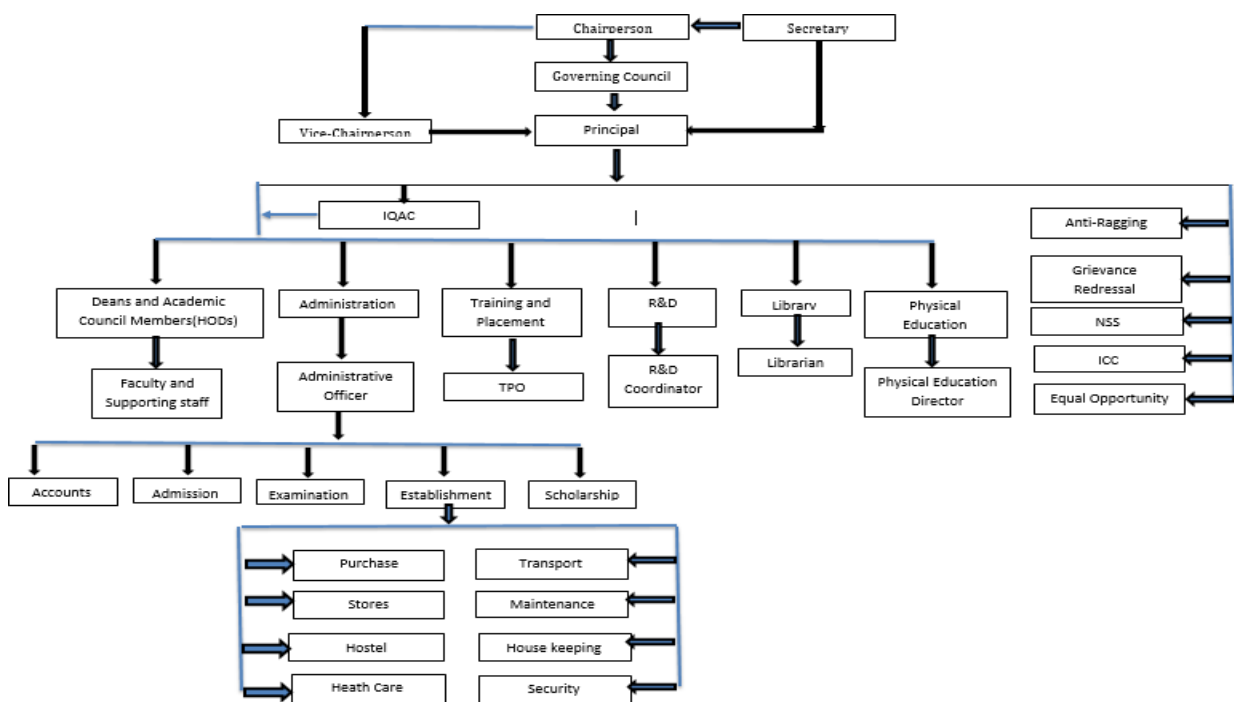

Agenda Items & Proceedings

1. **Implementation of ERP with Juno Campus:** The committee discussed the proposal for integrating the Juno Campus ERP system to streamline academic, administrative, finance, and examination processes.

Resolution: The members approved the implementation of the ERP system in a phased manner. A technical team will coordinate with Juno Campus for deployment and training. Implementation expected to begin from January 2026.

2. **Digital Transparency Initiative for the Campus:** The IQAC emphasized the importance of enhancing digital governance and transparency in all institutional operations.

Resolution: It was decided to upgrade existing digital systems and introduce new tools for real-time data access. All departments will update academic and administrative information regularly on the institutional website. A Digital Transparency Committee will be formed to monitor compliance.

3. **Collaboration with Cambridge University for English Soft Skills:** A proposal was reviewed regarding collaboration with Cambridge University (or Cambridge-affiliated programs) for enhancing students' English proficiency and communication skills.

Resolution: IQAC approved initiating a formal communication with Cambridge University/affiliated centres. The English Department will prepare a draft MoU and coordinate with the international relations cell. Pilot training programs to begin for first-year students.

4. **Collaboration with Seminarroom for Value-Added Programs:** The committee discussed offering value-added certification programs through industry-aligned partners such as Seminarroom.

Resolution: Collaboration was approved, subject to reviewing the detailed course modules and fee structure. Value-added courses will be introduced in the upcoming academic year. Departments will identify programs suitable for their students.

5. **Accreditation Process - NAAC and UGC 2(f):** The progress on NAAC accreditation and UGC 2(f) recognition was reviewed.

Resolution: NAAC preparation work, including data compilation, SSR drafting, and quality metrics verification, must be expedited. All departments must submit updated documents to IQAC within two weeks. The committee confirmed that necessary steps for UGC 2(f) submission will be completed by June 2025.

The meeting concluded with the Chairperson emphasising the importance of timely execution of all action points. The next IQAC review meeting will be scheduled in July 2025. The Meeting adjourned at: 1:00 PM.


